

Certificate 11 - Nail technology

Standard entry level qualification for the beauty industry:

Certificate 11 in nail technology consists of working with clearly defined context under supervision. It involves interacting with customers, providing manicure and pedicure services, applying acrylic or gel nail enhancements and applying nail art.

Qualification requirements: To achieve a Certificate 11 in Nail Technology, a total of 13 units must be completed. This comprises of:

Duration: Two days a week for 6 - 8 weeks
